



# These He Also Glorified

**Scripture Reading:** Romans 8.28-39

### Introduction:

The language of Romans 8.28-30 is unusual. Seems to speak of God's people already being in heaven. *These He also glorified*. How can it be spoken of as already having happened when it has not?

### I. In God's mind, redemption is \_\_\_\_\_.

- A. The final destiny of His people is so sure...so certain...that God can speak of it as already accomplished. 8.30.
  - 1. Done for the specific purpose of giving assurance and hope to His people.

### II. God wants us with Him in \_\_\_\_\_.

- A. Romans 8.17-18 – God has made us His children, and made us joint \_\_\_\_\_ with Christ.
  - 1. Hebrew 10.23 – God keeps His word.

### III. God has made every \_\_\_\_\_ for us.

- A. God has put everything in place to open the door wide for us.
  - 1. Romans 8.28 – everything God has put into His plan is for our good.
- B. 8.31-32 – Since God did not spare Jesus, do you think He will spare anything else?
- C. There is nothing \_\_\_\_\_. This is why Peter wrote 2 Peter 1.3-4.

### IV. This is no hidden \_\_\_\_\_ in God's plan.

- A. There is no monkey wrench in the works...there is nothing to outwit or thwart God's plan!
  - 1. Doesn't mean that there is nothing to oppose God and His plan.
- B. 8.33-39 – assurance all through these verses.
- C. There is no foil, no hidden thing that will \_\_\_\_\_ God's plan for our redemption.

### Conclusion:

- A. Blessed assurance...Jesus is mine!
- B. We *know* and we *believe* what God says about our redemption. Don't let anyone or anything take away the joy of your salvation!
